PRODUCT NAME

Furosemide Injection BP

MEDICINAL USE

Potent diuretic and antihypertensive

PRINCIPAL CONSTITUENT

Furosemide

APPEARANCE

Clear Colourless Solution

HEALTH HAZARD

Variable and erratic absorption from GI tract (Bioavailability 60-70%). May produce fluid and electrolyte imbalance arising from diuretic action. May induce hyperglycaemia and glycosuria. May Cause severe skin rashes and photosensitivity reactions

FIRE HAZARD

Extinguishant in its liquid form

STORAGE

As defined on the label

HANDLING

Handle glass ampoule with care. Wear hand protection when opening

SPILLAGE

Wear gloves if glass is broken. Absorb spillage onto absorbent material. Wash area well with soap and warm water. Dispose of as a special pharmaceutical waste

DISPOSAL

Treat as special pharmaceutical waste

EMERGENCY ACTION

SKIN CONTAMINATION

Wash the affected area thoroughly with soap and warm water

EYE CONTAMINATION

Irrigate with water for at least five minutes

INGESTION

Give water to drink and seek medical advice

INHALATION

If liquid inhaled, seek urgent medical advice
