

**MATERIALS INFORMATION SHEET- Lidocaine Injection BP with Preservative (Vials)**

**PRODUCT NAME**

Lidocaine Injection BP with Preservative (Vials)

**MEDICINAL USE**

Local anaesthetic of the amide type.

**PRINCIPAL CONSTITUENT**

Lidocaine (INN) with Methyl and Propyl Hydroxybenzoates

**APPEARANCE**

Clear Colourless Solution

**HEALTH HAZARD**

Allergic reaction of inhaled, ingested or in contact with skin. Local anaesthesia and central nervous system reactions - dizziness, blurred vision, tremors, possible hypersensitivity reaction with topical contact. Preservatives may cause delayed contact dermatitis

**FIRE HAZARD**

Extinguishant in its liquid form

**STORAGE**

As defined on the label

**HANDLING**

Handle glass vials with care.

**SPILLAGE**

Wear gloves if glass has broken. Absorb spillage onto absorbent material. Wash area well with soap and warm water. Dispose of as special pharmaceutical waste

**DISPOSAL**

Treat as special pharmaceutical waste

**EMERGENCY ACTION**

**SKIN CONTAMINATION**

Wash the affected area thoroughly with soap and warm water

**EYE CONTAMINATION**

Irrigate with water for at least five minutes. May produce local anaesthesia, seek medical advice

**INGESTION**

Give water to drink and seek medical advice

**INHALATION**

Avoid inhalation - respiratory tract irritation and difficulty with breathing. Seek medical advice
