PRODUCT NAME

Atropine Sulphate Injection BP

MEDICINAL USE

Anticholinergic alkaloid with central and peripheral actions

PRINCIPAL CONSTITUENT

Atropine BP

APPEARANCE

Clear Colourless Solution

HEALTH HAZARD

Dilation of pupils and loss of accommodation.

Dryness of mouth, flushing, giddiness. Transient bradycardia followed by tachycardia with palpitations and arrhythmias. Vomiting

FIRE HAZARD

Extinguishant in its liquid form

STORAGE

As defined on the label

HANDLING

Handle glass ampoule with care. Wear hand protection when opening

SPILLAGE

Wear gloves if glass has broken. Absorb spillage onto absorbent material. Wash area well with soap and warm water. Dispose of as special pharmaceutical waste

DISPOSAL

Treat as special pharmaceutical waste

EMERGENCY ACTION

SKIN CONTAMINATION

Wash the affected area thoroughly with soap and warm water

EYE CONTAMINATION

Irrigate with water for at least five minutes

INGESTION

Give water to drink and seek medical advice

INHALATION

If liquid inhaled, seek urgent medical advice
